The Cape or Red Hartebeest and Lichtensteins Hartebeest. The former is confined to Africa south of the Limpopo River, but the latter, which inhabits the north eastern portion of South Africa, ranges into Central Africa. The Dutch Voortrekkers gave the name of Harte beest to this antelope from a fancied resemblance to a hart or stag, an animal which in point of size and colour it somewhat resembles.
